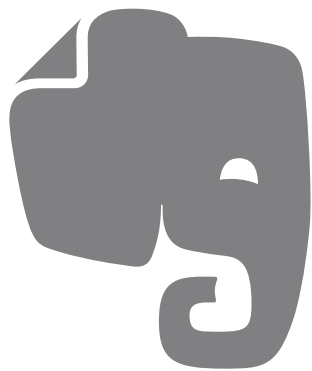


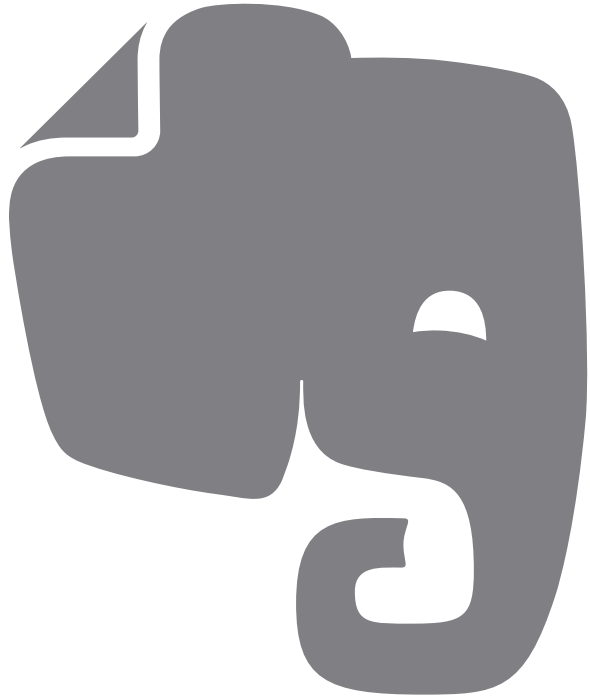

HOW?

The Process

1. Review Evernote content.
2. Purge old, useless, unneeded data.
3. Create local repo.
4. Move, copy, paste content from Evernote to a local repo.
5. Step and repeat.

The Tools

1. Bitbucket (free, unlimited private repos)
2. Local computer
3. SourceTree
4. Atom (as a preferred text editor)
5. iTerm2
6. Working Copy app (for iPhone) – \$15

Benefits

1. Almost as organized/searchable as Evernote
2. Not subject to Evernote's – or anyone else's – terms and conditions (ish)
3. Increased understanding of version control
4. Improved fluency in terminal commands
